

Legal Notice

The Boston Region Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is proposing an amendment to the federal fiscal years (FFYs) 2009 and 2010 elements of the FFYs 2007–2010 Transportation Improvement Program and Air Quality Conformity Determination.

This proposed amendment would make changes to the highway and transit programs. The changes include updates to transit funding and revisions to the highway program to reflect projects proposed for programming in the FFY 2009 element of the future Draft FFYs 2009–2012 TIP.

A 30-day public-comment period will begin on Tuesday, September 22, 2008. It will close at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, October 21. A meeting to take action on the amendment is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, October 23, 2008. It will begin at 10:00 AM in a conference room of the State Transportation Building, 10 Park Plaza, Boston. Members of the public are invited to attend. Comments will be accepted in writing before the close of the public-comment period and at the meeting.
