Background

For the past 30 years, the Graphics Department of the Central Transportation Planning Staff (CTPS) has been responsible for many of the MBTA's maps. This includes the Official System Map, Rapid Transit Map, Commuter Rail Map, bus maps, and neighborhood maps. When needed, CTPS has been contracted to update and correct these maps.

Objectives

Beginning in the spring of 2023 and until 2027, the MBTA will annually add or change 15-20 bus routes. These changes will have repercussions throughout the system and

require many maps to be updated. Also, various forms of public outreach will be required to inform the riders of the pending changes.

Work Description

The work required to accomplish the objectives will be carried out in five tasks as described below:

Task 1 Update the MBTA Official System Map

By June 2023, the MBTA Official System Map will be updated to include the 15-20 bus route changes.
